CONFIDENTIAL--ENTIRE TEXT

REFTELS A AND B REPORT SYSTEMATIC MASSACRES IN
SOUTHEASTERN RWANDA. THE RWANDAN PATRIOTIC ARMY (RPA) MAY
BE ENGAGED IN AN ETHNIC CLEANSING CAMPAIGN TO DRIVE HUTUS
OUT OF THE REGION SO THAT TUTSI REFUGEES FROM BURUNDI AND
GANDA CAN TAKE OVER THEIR LAND.

IF THE SYG REPORTS THAT EVIDENCE INDICATES THAT THE
RPA IS INVOLVED IN ETHNIC CLEANSING, ACTS OF GENOCIDE OR
WAR CRIMES, MISSION IS INSTRUCTED TO CIRCULATE A DRAFT
NSC PRESIDENTIAL STATEMENT FOLLOWING THE SYG'S REPORT TO
THE COUNCIL ABOUT THESE CHARGES. TEXT AND POINTS THAT
FOLLOW ARE THE RESULT OF PRELIMINARY INFORMATION AND MAY
BE MODIFIED BASED ON THE CONTENTS OF THE SYG'S
REPORT.

BEGIN TEXT OF PROPOSED DRAFT PRESIDENTIAL STATEMENT:

THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS ALARMED AT REPORTS OF CONTINUING
MASSACRES AND OTHER HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS IN RWANDA. IT
IS ESSENTIAL THAT REFUGEES NOW IN BORDERING COUNTRIES BE
ASSURED THEY MAY RETURN TO THEIR HOMES WITH SECURITY. IT
IS ALSO ESSENTIAL THAT THE CYCLE OF REVENGE FOLLOWING
REVENGE BE ENDED IN RWANDA.

THE SECURITY COUNCIL REAFFIRMS ITS GOAL OF BRINGING PEACE
WITH JUSTICE TO RWANDA. IT CALLS ON ALL PARTIES TO HONOR
THE HUMAN RIGHTS OF ALL RWANDANS, AND IMMEDIATELY TO CEASE
SUMMARY EXECUTIONS, TERRORISM AGAINST ETHNIC GROUPS AND
REFUGEES, AND SEIZURE OF LAND AND PROPERTY BELONGING TO
REFUGEES.

THE SECURITY COUNCIL APPEALS TO THE GOVERNMENT OF RWANDA
TO EXERT DISCIPLINE OVER ITS ARMY, NOT TO TOLERATE ETHNIC
MURDERS AND REVENGE KILLINGS, AND TO TAKE PROMPT PENAL
ACTION AGAINST THOSE WHO HAVE COMMITTED WAR CRIMES AND
CRIMES AGAINST HUMANITY.

THE SECURITY COUNCIL CALLS UPON THE GOVERNMENT OF RWANDA
TO ASSIST UNITED NATIONS HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS AND UNAMIR
FORCES DEPLOYED IN RWANDA, AND REQUESTS THAT UNAMIR SEND
ADDITIONAL FORCES TO THE SOUTHEASTERN REGION OF THE
COUNTRY.

END TEXT OF DRAFT PRESIDENTIAL STATEMENT.

5. IN DISCUSSING THE ABOVE DRAFT STATEMENT, MISSION
SHOULD MAKE THE FOLLOWING POINTS:

BEGIN TALKING POINTS:

--IN RECENT WEEKS, (NHCR, THE U.S. EMBASSIES IN KIGALI AND
BUJUMBURA (REF C, D, E), AND NGO HUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS (REF
F) HAVE RECEIVED REPORTS THAT RWANDAN PATRIOTIC ARMY
FORCES IN SOUTHEASTERN RWANDA HAVE ENGAGED IN REVENGE
KILLINGS. THE MOST RECENT REPORT BY UNHCR (REFTEL A, B)
CORROBORATES THESE ACCOUNTS AND SUGGESTS THAT THE ATTACKS
MAY BE MUCH MORE WIDESPREAD AND SYSTEMATIC THAN ORIGINALLY
REPORTED.

--IF THE KILLINGS CONTINUE, HUTU REFUGEES WILL NOT RETURN
TO RWANDA. THE AGONY OF RWANDA WILL BE FURTHER PROLONGED,
AND THE BURDEN ON THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY WILL

INCREASE.

--THE UN SECURITY COUNCIL SHOULD THEREFORE STRONGLY
CONDEMN THESE KILLINGS, AND SHOULD DEMAND THAT THEY BE
STOPPED.

--THE SECURITY COUNCIL SHOULD ALSO CALL FOR UNAMIR TO
EXPAND ITS PRESENCE IN THE REGION WHERE THE KILLINGS HAVE
BEEN MOST MASSIVE, THE SOUTHEASTERN ZONE, AND SHOULD CALL
ON THE GOVERNMENT OF RWANDA TO ASSIST UNAMIR AND UN HUMAN
RIGHTS MONITORS THROUGHOUT RWANDA.

--WE ARE CURRENTLY CIRCULATING A UN SECURITY COUNCIL
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MEMBER STATES TO DETAIN THOSE WHO
HAVE COMMITTED GENOCIDE AND OTHER VIOLATIONS OF
INTERNATIONAL HUMANITARIAN LAW. WE URGE ADOPTION OF BOTH
THE STATEMENT WE HAVE DISCUSSED TODAY AND THAT RESOLUTION.
