**1. FISCAL YEAR 1995**

**Army:**

No security assistance training taught.

**Air Force:**

No security assistance training taught.

**Navy:**

Course: Expanded IMET Phase II of the Military Justice Seminar at the Naval War College, Newport, Rhode Island, 24-30 Jun 95, for eight RPA junior officers.

Texts: (Box number 1) Course syllabus, Manual for Courts -Martial United States, 1995 Edition; various handout cover practical exercises in Evidence; Civil Law booklet on Bird Exercise; administrative booklet; three ring binder containing the Judge Advocate Generals Manual and other legal office instructions; one set of seven 3.5 inch computer disks containing various extracts from legal manuals and course outlines (formatted for Word Perfect).

Course: International Defense Management Course, Monterey, California, 25 Sep-8 Dec 95, one RPA officer attended.

Texts: (Box number 2) three ring binder labeled Defense Resource Management Institute containing welcome aboard booklet, course outline and schedules, advance information on the course, and various class outlines; 1960 Rand Corporation study entitled "The Economics of Defense in the Nuclear Age"; spiral binder text book on QSB + programming; textbooks entitled: Applied Management Science, Introduction to Decision Analysis, Micro Economy Today, Analysis for Public Decisions, Essentials of Management, Government Budgeting and Expenditure Controls Theory and Practice, and Fundamentals of Management.

## 2. FISCAL YEAR 1996

**Army:** No IMET training was conducted by Army in FY96. Army did conduct demining training through an FMS case with a total cost of \$207,000. The Mobile Training Team (MTT) deployed to Rwanda on 30 Aug 96, and returned 6 Oct 96. Eleven Army personnel deployed in the MTT team and provided refresher training on demining to 56 Rwandan soldiers (11 officers and 45 enlisted).

**Course:** Mobile Training Team (MTT) Demining Refresher Training.

**Texts:** (Box number 2) Training Circular 31-34 entitled "Humanitarian Demining Operations Handbook"

**Air Force:** Air Force conducted no IMET training during FY96.

**Navy:** Navy conducted two IMET Military Justice Seminar Mobile Education Teams (METs) in Kigali, Rwanda and taught two students in CONUS.

**Course:** Phase IV and V of the Naval Justice Seminar in Kigali during the periods 29 April-3 May 96, for 34 RPA officers and enlisted personnel and 6-21 Sept 96 for 36 military and civilian justice officials.

**Texts:** (Box number 1) Course syllabus, two 3.5 inch computer disks labeled Rwanda Phase 4 and Phase 5 (formatted for Word Perfect) containing course outlines and training forms.

**Course:** International Defense Management Course, Monterey, CA, 16 Sep-6 Dec 96, for one RPA officer.

**Texts:** (Box number 2) same as previous course taught in FY95--(see above).

Course: Two RPA officers attended the Civil-Military Strategy for International Development at Hurlbert Field, Florida, during the period 28 Jul-8 Aug 97.
