- 2. SUMMARY. AF ASSISTANT SECRETARY MOOSE AND HIS FRENCH AND BELGIAN COUNTERPARTS DISCUSSED ZAIRE, RWAND BURUNDI JANUARY 16 IN PARIS.
- 3. ON ZAIRE, THEY REVIEWED THE KENGO GOVERNMENT'S PROGRESS ON POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC REFORM, OBSTRUCTIONIST TACTICS OF HOBUTU'S ENTOURAGE, THE COPTINUING ROLE OF PRESIDENT HOBUTU IN THE TRANSITION, AND THE PROSPECTS FOR ELECTIONS IN 1995. A/S MOOSE SUGGESTED THE THREE SHOULD ESTABLISH TRILATERAL CRITERIA FOR WHAT WOULD CONSTITUTE ADEQUATE PREPARATION FOR ELECTIONS!

HOWEVER, WE REMAINED CONCERNED THAT KENGO WOULD PRESS TOO HARD AND FORCE MOBUTU TO REACT.
