((FBIS Translated Text)) The Government of Tanzania has said it is ready to cooperate with the international tribunal which will hear charges against all suspects alleged to have been involved in the ruthless killings in Rwanda.

This pledge was made today by the minister for foreign affairs and international cooperation, Honorable Joseph Rwegasira, when he addressed a press conference in his office.

He said the Tanzanian Government is ready to hand over suspects who are refugees residing in the country if it becomes evident that they were involved in one way or another in the massacre of innocent Rwandan citizens.

It is estimated that nearly 1 million victims died in the massacre that erupted soon after that country's president, Mr. Juvenal Habyarimana, was killed in a plane crash in April last year.

Honorable Rwegasira said at present Rwandan nationals were reluctant to return home for fear of personal safety. He said, however, leaders from East and Central Africa who recently met in Nairobi, Kenya, saw the need to assure Rwandan nationals of their safety when they returned home with assistance from the international community for the reconstruction of Rwanda.
